1. Report on last 50 Errors in default System Log
 1. `sudo tail -50 /var/log/syslog`

What I ended up doing was renaming the my.cnf file and letting MySQL regenerate it and it fixed it up.

1. `sudo mv /etc/mysql/my.cnf /etc/mysql/oldmy.cnf`
